## CARE OF THE COURSE

(Please observe Signs & Directions at all times)

- (a) **ALL PLAYERS MUST REPORT TO PROSHOP AT ALL TIMES BEFORE USING COURSE**
- (b) Replace and repair all divots by carrying and using Sand Buckets - even when using a carry bag.
- (c) Repair lob marks on the Green.
- (d) Players must rake bunkers after use in competition and social play. Always leave a bunker by the way you entered it.
- (e) **Practice on TEES, FAIRWAYS, ROUGH, IN BUNKERS OR TO THE GREEN IS NOT PERMITTED.**
- (f) Please use the Practice Areas provided. Practice areas are not open on Competition days
- (g) Members playing a social ROUND of golf are permitted to play 2 balls only PER HOLE. (not from the same place)
- (h) Members are requested to ask youths trespassing on the Club's property to leave the course.
- (i) Members are requested not to buy balls under any circumstances from persons on or around the course. This only encourages stealing.
- (j) Wide Wheel Buggies are mandatory on the course.
- (k) **AT ALL TIMES THE GROUND STAFF HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY.**

## SLOW PLAY

The regular occurrence of "Slow Play" is discussed consistently among members, and with the thought that almost every player/member of the Club has at some time expressed concern, about the effects of Slow Play on their enjoyment of the game, we publish the following ten suggestions which could be of assistance in overcoming the problem.

1. Not being ready on time - **Select club and ball while other players are having their shots.**
2. Delays on tees or greens while marking the card - **Always mark the card while awaiting your turn at the tee.**
3. Players wait with others on the tee until all have played their shot, then walk to their own ball. - **Walk directly to your own ball, or level with same, and select club to be used while waiting for others to play their shots.**
4. Unnecessary number of practice swings - **It is agreed that each player has his own preference in this matter, but practice swings should be limited by discretion.**
5. Delays in locating lost balls - **If, after a reasonable period (3minutes), it is apparent you are holding up play call next group through.**
6. Lack of discretion in going through a team that has lost a ball - **If called ahead as in (5) but immediately afterwards the team ahead locate their ball and it is evident that play will proceed faster if they continue; you should signal them to go ahead.**

**NOTE: The discretion is in the hands of the team called through and not the players who were looking for the lost ball.**

7. On the putting green unnecessary marking of ball and players not continuing to putt out - **On reaching the green and your ball, study the line of your ball, study the line of your putt immediately. When it is your turn to putt, try and**

wherever possible putt right out. Marking the ball is sometimes unnecessary, but not always and should be avoided.

8. Players not using the time on the green, while waiting their turn, to assess their own putt - **Whenever possible, a player should have assessed his own putt for direction and speed while the other players are putting, providing in doing so, no interference is caused to the other players.**
9. Incorrect handling of the flag, on the green - **The player nearest the hole should attend the flag and then pass to the first player to hole out, then appraise his own putt.**
10. Leaving buggies around the green on the wrong side of the tee – **Always place your buggy adjacent to the approach to the next tee.**

**“BY FAR THE MOST IMPORTANT RULE IS BRIEF”**

Each player walks directly to or adjacent to his or her ball at all times, and waits there for the player furthest from the hole to play his or her shot. That he has used that time to assess his own shot.

**We ask you all to get into the habit of playing this way, and if you see anybody NOT playing this way, this is why you are having a slow round.**

## **RULES OF THE CLUB**

(To be read in conjunction with the By-Laws)

### **RULE 1 - DRESS REGULATIONS**

The Club's dress code is required to be met whenever you visit Cabramatta Golf Club.

It encompasses the entire precinct including the car park, Clubhouse and surrounds, the course and the practice facilities.

The General Manager may object at any time to dress they consider unsuitable as per this dress code. The members are responsible for the dress of their visitors.

#### **Club House**

- Members and visitors must be neat and tidy in appearance. No hats of any type are to be worn in the Club House this includes Hoodies that are worn over the head. No muscle shirts, singlets or tank tops.

Members and visitors must be wearing suitable footwear in the Clubhouse.

Note: the exception to the above is Mondays to Saturdays where working apparel is permitted.

#### **On the Course and when utilising the Practice Facilities**

Members and visitors must wear, clean neat and tidy golfing attire (of a style similar to the apparel stocked in our Golf Shop or as displayed on our notice board). Golf shoes (no metal spikes), joggers, sports shoes with socks must be worn on the golf course and practice facilities.

**“Shirts must have a collar”**

## **Unacceptable attire when utilising the Course or Practice Facilities**

- Shorts with a drawstring or elastic waist, stubbies, board-shorts,
- Football or sporting type shorts, jumpers and boots,
- Singlets, tank-tops, midriff tops, boob tubes, and tee-shirts,
- Tracksuits and gym wear,
- Leggings/jeggings (unless worn under a skirt/skort, tops or dresses. Tops and dresses are to extend to a minimum mid thigh in length),
- No holey, frayed, ripped or torn clothing is to be worn.

---

## **RULE 2 – HOUSE**

- (a) The clubhouse is open for the use of all Members and Visitors.
- (b) Members introducing Visitors must ensure that their guest's name, club and address are entered in the Visitor's Register.
- (c) Members are asked to support the Club by purchasing from the Bar, Restaurant and Pro Shop.
- (d) Members are encouraged to use club facilities for Weddings, Birthdays, Anniversaries or that Special Occasion. Members may also sponsor friends for such Function. The office will be happy to assist with any enquiry.

**N.B.** Regulations regarding Minors are necessary to comply with the Licensing Laws.

## **RULE 3 - COMPLAINTS**

- (a) All complaints or recommendations shall be made in writing to the General Manager who shall submit same to the appropriate Committee.
- (b) **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL ANY PERSON REPRIMAND AN EMPLOYEE OF THE CLUB.**

**EFTPOS - ATM facilities are available for payment of** subscriptions: Where Members elect to pay Fees Half-Yearly or Quarterly their attention is drawn to the following:-

- i) Any member having paid their fee on a quarterly or half yearly basis, and who cease to remain a Member for the balance of the year whether by resignation, expulsion or failing to pay the balance of fees by the due date shall forfeit all rights as a Member but still remain liable for all outstanding fees due and unpaid at the time of the cessation of Membership.

Full Members transferring from Full to Social Membership must do so for the full 12 month Membership period, otherwise a re-entry fee of \$70.00 will apply.

## **RULE 5 – PARKING**

- (a) To avoid inconvenience to other members, cars are to be parked in the marked areas provided for this purpose.
- (b) Parking in driveways on the main entrance to the Club is not permitted.
- (c) Please do not park in areas designated for other purposes e.g. Directors, Staff, etc.
- (d) Members attention is drawn to break-ins in the parking area – do not leave valuables in a conspicuous place. Keep cars securely locked at all times.

**“ALL CARE TAKEN BUT NO RESPONSIBILITY”.**

## **RULE 6 - PERSONAL PROPERTY & INSURANCE**

- (a) The Club is not liable for any loss, injury or damage to the property or person of any Member or Visitor on the Club's premises.
- (b) Members and Visitors golf clubs should not be left unattended outside the Clubhouse (Theft on many occasions have been reported).
- (c) All Members are advised to ensure that any valuable or personal belongings left in the Locker Room are always under lock and key.
- (d) Members should report any incident involving damage or likely damage caused by a ball being hit into private property.
- (e) The General Manager is to be notified as soon as possible of claims under the Members Insurance Scheme.

---

## **RULE 7 - MOTORISED CARTS & MOTOR BIKES**

- (a) Drivers of Motorised Carts must hold a current Motor Vehicle License.
- (b) There **MUST NOT** be more than 2 persons to each Motorised Cart.
- (c) Carts **MUST NOT** be driven over tees and **MUST NOT** be driven within Ten (10) metres of any green.
- (d) Carts **MUST NOT** be driven between Bunkers and Greens or on shoulders of greens.
- (e) Carts **MUST** use the pathways provided.
- (f) Only 2 sets of clubs are permitted for each Motorised Cart.
- (g) Players failing to comply with the above rules, could lose their privilege to drive carts.
- (h) Visitors are prohibited from bringing Motorised Ride-on transportation to use on the course.

## **RULE 8 - MATCH COMMITTEE**

- (a) **TEE TIME:** Cards must be collected fifteen (15) minutes before the booked hitting off time. Failure to observe this ruling will result in loss of booked hitting off time.
- (b) **BEFORE PLAY:** Members should look at the Local Rules Board before starting play, for they are deemed to be aware of all notices, local rules, etc.
- (c) **CANCELLATIONS:** Members are requested to notify a cancellation of their booked time as early as possible and preferably no later than the day prior to the event. Members who fail to attend for their booked time and do not advise of their cancellation will be penalised.

- 72 Holes Net Event - Net Winner each Grade Top 24 Plus Ties to be seeded in 3rd Round.  
Top 12 Plus Ties to be seeded in 4th (final) Round.  
The leaders in the Senior and Juniors may be paired together in the Final Round.

### **Foursomes Championship**

- Net Winners each Grade: Scratch Winners each Grade.
- 36 Hole Scratch Event - Scratch Winners each Grade and Scratch Runners-up each Grade.
- 36 Hole Net Event - Net Winners each Grade.

**Please note:** To be eligible for the 36 Hole Net Trophy, both players **MUST BE** in the same handicap Grade.

Players cannot win the **2BBB, 2B Multiplier, 2B Aggregate Net** or **Scratch** event **MORE THAN ONCE** with the same playing partner in a calendar month.

## **SCORECARDS**

The Rules of Golf (Rule 37) place the onus on the Competitor to see that his correct score is recorded by his marker for each hole. The score must be recorded on completion of play of each hole.

The competitor must;

- (1) ensure that the marker has signed the card;
- (2) countersign it himself;
- (3) ensure his handicap is recorded;
- (4) ensure the card has date entered;
- (5) ensure card is scanned into the computer and correct score is recorded.
- (6) place it in the competition slot at front of office immediately on completion of the round.

- 
- (d) **GOLF COMPETITIONS:** The normal Saturday, Sunday and Public Holiday competitions are set out in this Fixture Book. A two tee system is used for these competitions and tee times are normally available as follows: except for public holidays - 1 tee start -

**Saturday** In two blocks - the early block to approx 8.15am on Both tees, the later block from approx 11.00am on both tees.

**Sunday** Same as Saturday.

**Monday** The booking sheet is available (on computer). The event is an Open Medley 2B Stableford, 2B Multiplier or 2B Aggregate with a Single Stableford in conjunction. Tee times are available from 7.00am to 12.30pm.

**Wednesday** The booking sheet is available one week in advance. The event is an Open 2BBB Stableford, Multiplier, or 2B Aggregate with a Singles stableford in conjunction. Tee times are available from 6.30am to 12.30pm. The third Wednesday (Whopper Wednesday) in the month is a 2B Aggregate Stableford and Singles.

**Booking Sheets:** Booking is essential for the weekend competitions. Bookings sheets are available two weeks before the event on line at 6.00pm on the Friday night. Club Phone bookings are not permitted on the day the booking sheets become available. Traditionally, the weekend booking sheets are booked out fairly quickly, however, with on line bookings, tee times become available at any given time which members can access.

## **CHAMPIONSHIP GRADES**

For Club Singles Championship, a Member's Grade shall be determined by his handicap at the commencement of the Championship

### **Singles Championships:**

A Grade limit 0	- 9
A.R Grade limit	10-14
B Grade limit	15- 20
C Grade limit	21- 36

**Foursomes:** Grade determined by handicap of lower marker in pair:

- A Grade limit 0 - 12
- B Grade limit 13 - 18
- C Grade limit 19 – 36

**NOTE:** To be eligible for the 36 hole net score, the players **MUST BE** in the same handicap grade.

---

## **COCK O'WALK MATCH PLAY KNOCKOUT**

The following conditions apply for the handicap format:

"The lowest marker reverts to scratch and gives strokes to the higher markers, eg. A is on a 4 handicap, B on 8, C on 12 and D on 27. A receives no strokes, B gets 4 strokes, C gets 8 strokes and D gets 23 strokes.

## **AMBROSE EVENTS**

All Ambrose events will be preferred lies through the green, bunkers included.

## **MEMBERS CHRISTMAS EVENT**

1. Teams of 6 add all handicaps together and divide by 12. Teams of five divide by 10. Teams of 4 divided by 8.
2. Teams are split in half with 3 players hitting from the odd tees and the other hitting from the even tees. The 3 players play alternate shots. The 6 never hit or putt from the same spot unless all 3 hit out of bounds.
3. **ALL PLAYERS ARE ONLY ALLOWED TO CARRY A MAXIMUM OF 14 GOLF CLUBS, INCLUDING PUTTER.**

## NOTES

- (a) Competition of the day will remain valid unless called off by the Match Committee prior to the last tee off time listed on the day's starter's sheet.
- (b) Suspension of play due to the course being temporarily unplayable because of heavy rain or lightning does not automatically make a competition invalid.
- (c) Only competition cards placed in the competition slot at office prior to the close of the competition may be considered for trophy and ball competition allocation. All cards including non returned cards will be handicapped in accordance with the AGU handicapping procedures.
- (d) Should a competition be declared invalid by the appropriate club official, all starters will be entitled to a refund of competition fees paid for that competition.

**The Match Committee reserves the right to alter or adjust the Trophy allocation or following Program if it considers such adjustments are in the best interests of the Club.**

---

## DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

For all play at this course, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is **DISQUALIFICATION**, regardless of whether any such additional function is used.

For any failure to observe these requirements, penalties as provided in the Rules of Golf will be applied.

### **Returning Score Card:**

**ALL SINGLES CARDS MUST BE RETURNED.** Failure to return singles cards will result in **disqualification from the two ball event.**

## TIES IN COMPETITION

In Match Play, if players have squared the match after the stipulated holes per round or rounds, they shall continue to play and the match shall be won by the player or players who first wins another hole.

In the event of two or more players returning the same or equal scores in a Stroke, Par or Stableford competition, the winner will be decided by a countback.

**Excepting** in the 72 Holes Stroke, Club Championships, A ,AR, B and C Grade, Cabramatta Cup, Gold Medal Round, Mixed Foursomes Championships and Foursomes Championships. In the event of a tie in the Cabramatta Cup, Foursomes Championships, Mixed Foursomes Championships and Gold Medal Round, a play-off over 18 holes will be played to decide the winner. Should a tie result, the winner will be decided by a “sudden death” play-off over three holes; 16th, 17th, 18th to determine Scratch Winner and Runner-up.

---

## PLAY-OFFS

In the Cabramatta Cup, Foursomes Championships, Mixed Foursomes Championships and the Club Championships "A", "AR" "B" and "C" Grades, the play-off applies to the Scratch Event - the winner of the Handicap Event will be decided by countback. In the Gold Medal Round the playoff applies to the Handicap Event.

## PROTESTS

Any competitor desiring to enter a protest in connection with a match or competition shall do so in writing, addressed to the General Manager and shall deposit same in the slot with cards of play. The General Manager shall, upon the receipt of such protest, convene at the earliest possible opportunity, a meeting of the Match Committee, who shall consider such protest and whose decision shall be final. Protests must be entered immediately on completion of the match or competition.

## ELIGIBILITY FOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

To be eligible for the third and final rounds of the Club Championships A A.Reserve, B & C Grades, a member must have joined the Club prior to 1st January this year.

A Member who joined the Club after this date is eligible to play in the 18 hole daily event only. (Not the Championships)

## ELIGIBILITY FOR JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Junior members **MUST** declare Cabramatta Golf Club **HOME CLUB** and be eligible to play Pennants for all teams.

---

## PLAY-OFFS

Where players could compete for more than one trophy (e.g. scratch and net), a player is restricted to receiving one trophy only. In this respect the order of precedence will be:-

- (1) Handicap Event;
- (2) Scratch Event;

Except in the case of the Cabramatta Cup, Club Championships, Foursomes and Mixed Foursomes Championships where order of precedence will be:-

- (1) Scratch Event;
- (2) Handicap Event.

In the Club Championships this applies to the 72 Hole Event, in the Foursomes and Mixed Foursomes Championships this applies to the 36 hole event.

In each round for the Club Championships, Foursomes and Mixed Foursomes Championships the precedence will be:-

- (1) Net Event;
- (2) Scratch Event.

**MIXED FOURSOMES:** In the Mixed Foursomes Championships, Members will play from the 1st Tee for the first round then from alternate Tees thereafter Associates from the 1st Tee the second round then from alternate Tees thereafter.

**GENERAL:** The President and Captain, or in their absence their representatives, shall have the right of the course at any time should they desire to exercise their privilege, (Including 4 blocked times on the Saturday/Sunday Starting Sheet)

In competition extended over a period, players will play off their handicap at the date of play, except that original handicap will apply for aggregate score in net events which are over more than 18 holes.

A Junior Member under 18 years of age, is not permitted to mark the card of another Junior Member who is also under 18 years of age. Penalty: **“Disqualification”**.

## ETIQUETTE OF THE GAME OF GOLF

**Safety:** Players should ensure that no one is standing close by or in a position to be hit by the club or ball and should not play until the group in front is out of range.

**Consideration for other players:** Players should always show consideration for other players on the course and should not disturb their play by moving, talking or making unnecessary noise. Players should not stand close to or directly behind the ball, or directly behind the hole when a player is about to play.

**On the Putting Green:** Players should not stand on another player's line of putt.

**Scoring:** In stroke play, a player who is acting as marker, should if necessary, on the way to the next tee, check the score with the player concerned and record it.

**Pace of Play:** Players should play at a good pace. The Committee may establish pace of play guidelines that all players should follow.

It is a group's responsibility to keep up with the group in front. If it loses a clear hole and it is delaying the group behind, it should invite that group to play through.

**Be Ready to Play:** Players should be ready to play when it is their turn.

**Lost Ball:** If a player believes his ball may be lost outside a water hazard or is out of bounds, to save time, he should play a provisional ball.

Players searching for a ball should signal the group behind to play through as soon as it becomes apparent that the ball will not be easily found. They should not search for five minutes before doing so. Having allowed the group behind to play through, they should not continue to play until that group is out of range.

**Care of the Course:** Before leaving a bunker, players should carefully smooth over all holes and footprints made by them and any nearby made by others.

Players should carefully repair any divot holes made by them and any damage to the putting green made by the impact of a ball (whether or not made by the player himself).

Players should avoid causing unnecessary damage to the course.

**Penalties for Breach:** If players follow these guidelines it will make the game more enjoyable for everyone.

In the case of a serious breach of etiquette, the Committee may disqualify a player under Rule 33-7.

## CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Club Championships to be played over 54 holes in three grades A Grade: 0 – 20 B Grade: 21 – 27 C Grade: 28 – 45

**Foursomes Championships** to be played over 36 holes in two divisions. Divisions will be determined by numbers in the field.

In the event of a tie in the club championship or foursomes (best gross in all divisions) an 18 hole play-off will take place. If still tied a sudden death play-off will commence on the 1st hole.

**Veterans Championships** to be held over 36 holes on the final two rounds of club championships.

**Cabra Bowl Nett Event** to be played over 36 holes.

**Junior Championships** held in conjunction with Cabra Bowl with a minimum of 4 players.

**All championships to be played off red markers.**

**Monthly medals** played in 3 divisions: 0 – 20, 21– 27, 28–45.

In the event of a tie an 18 hole play-off will take place on the next medal round.

**Gold Medal:** all medal winners during the year are eligible. In the event of a tie an 18 hole play-off will take place.

**4Ball Matchplay** – 8 pairs to qualify -  $\frac{3}{4}$  the difference of handicap. **Single Matchplay** – 8 to qualify - full difference of handicap

There must be a minimum of 16 players in the qualifying round.



## Dress Code

The Club's dress code is required to be met whenever you visit Cabramatta Golf Club.

It encompasses the entire precinct including the car park, Clubhouse and surrounds, the course and the practice facilities.

The General Manager may object at any time to dress they consider unsuitable as per this dress code. The members are responsible for the dress of their visitors.

### Club House

- Members and visitors must be neat and tidy in appearance. No hats of any type are to be worn in the Club House this includes Hoodies that are worn over the head. No muscle shirts, singlets or tank tops.

Members and visitors must be wearing suitable footwear in the Clubhouse.

Note: the exception to the above is Mondays to Saturdays where working apparel is permitted.

### On the Course and when utilising the Practice Facilities

Members and visitors must wear, clean neat and tidy golfing attire (of a style similar to the apparel stocked in our Golf Shop or as displayed on our notice board). Golf shoes (no metal spikes), joggers, sports shoes with socks must be worn on the golf course and practice facilities.

**“Shirts must have a collar”**

## **Unacceptable attire when utilising the Course or Practice Facilities**

- Shorts with a drawstring or elastic waist, stubbies, board-shorts,
- Football or sporting type shorts, jumpers and boots,
- Singlets, tank-tops, midriff tops, boob tubes, and tee-shirts,
- Tracksuits and gym wear,
- Leggings/jeggings (unless worn under a skirt/skort, tops or dresses. Tops and dresses are to extend to a minimum mid thigh in length),
- No holey, frayed, ripped or torn clothing is to be worn.
